

# PROTECTING ORGANISATIONS FROM SEXUAL HARM



## A one day course for non-specialists

### Aim of the course:

To help participants better understand and manage the risk of sexual harm; including understanding their vulnerabilities to sexual offenders, the management of vulnerable individuals with behavioural disinhibition, the principles of safe photography and social media policies, working with partner organisations, safely working with known offenders, and ways of creating resilient procedures and spaces to protect clients and users. The course also gives participants some understanding of how to identify and report patterns of potentially risky behaviour. It complements and builds on training around child and adult safeguarding, focusing particularly on the prevention of sexual harm.

### Who is this course for?

This course is ideal for all those who manage groups or communities of users, either open groups such as theatre and arts organisations, youth groups and employability projects or closed groups such as faith groups, support or recovery fellowships, or other membership organisations. It is designed for those wishing to improve their safeguarding structures and practices in line with best practice guidance, and can be customised to focus on front-line staff, managers and trustees, or both.

### Who will deliver the training?

The training will be delivered by TDI's specialist training consultants who are expert in engaging with participants and helping them learn in a relaxed environment, whilst addressing sensitive and complex subjects.

The course runs over one day using interactive techniques and media, including group work, videos, case studies and discussion.
